

Create an Account

- 1. Go to the Apply Texas website: applytexas.org
- 2. Click on: GET STARTED
- 3. Sign up with a new account: Create a Username, enter your personal email, and Create a Password
- 4. Check your email for a message from ApplyTexas to verify your new account and complete your ApplyTexas profile.

My Profile

Page 1 – Names

Agree to the Privacy Policy and enter in your personal information.

You must enter the correct SS#. This is important for the purposes of identifying your application and college record.

You must enter your full legal name – do not use nicknames or abbreviations.

Click the arrow to advance to Page 2.

Page 2 – Background

Enter in your personal information and confirm that your name and date of birth are correct by checking the box.

Click the arrow to advance to Page 3.

Page 3 – Citizenship

Answer Yes or No to the question "Are you a U.S. Citizen?" then answer any additional required fields.

Click the arrow to advance to Page 4.

Page 4 – Permanent Address

Enter in your Permanent Address information, then select "Click to Verify Address".

Click the arrow to advance to Page 5.

Page 5 – Physical Address

If your Physical Address is the same as your Permanent Address, leave all fields blank. Click the arrow to advance to Page 6.

If your Physical Address is <u>different</u> from your Permanent Address, complete the fields then select "Click to Verify My Address". Click the arrow to advance to Page 6.

Page 6 – Phone Numbers

Enter in your Preferred Phone Number (numbers only - no dashes or parenthesis) and select the Preferred Phone Type.

Click the arrow to advance to Page 7.

Page 7 – Emergency Contact

Enter in the required information.

Click on the arrow to advance to Page 8.

Page 8 – High School/Secondary School

Search for your high school by typing in the school name – typing in the city name will not return a full list of area high schools. Select your high school name **with correct city** from the drop-down list.

Enter your Expected Graduation Date.

Click the arrow to advance to Page 9.

Page 9 – College History

Answer Yes or No to the question "Have you taken any college courses?"

Answer Yes or No to consent and agree that ApplyTexas and its partners may communicate with you.

Answer Yes or No to the question "Are you currently on academic suspension from the last college or university you attended?" Once you have verified you have completed all pages in the My Profile section, Click Done to complete your profile.

Two Year Questions

Page 1 – Education Background/Plans

- Fill in the required parent/guardian information
- 1. Answer Yes or No to the question "At any time in your life were you placed in foster care or adopted from foster care in Texas?"
- 2. Answer NO to the question "Are you home-schooled?", unless you are a homeschool student.
- 3. Answer Yes or No to the question "Did you take a Tech Prep course or courses for college credit?"
- 4. Please indicate on what basis you are seeking admission: Select Dual Credit (receiving both high school and college credit)
- 5. Please indicate the primary reason for attending classes at this college: Select Earn credits for transfer
- 6. Answer the questions regarding parents/guardians' education level.

Residency Questions

- 1. Answer the residency question "Of what country are you a resident?"
- 2. Answer the residency question "Of what state are you a resident?"
- 3. Answer Yes or No to the question "Are you claimed as a dependent or are you eligible to be claimed as a dependent by a parent or courtappointed legal guardian?"
- 4. Answer Yes or No to the question "Is the parent or legal guardian upon whom you base your claim of residency a U.S. Citizen?"
- 5. Answer Yes or No to the question "Does this parent or guardian live in Texas?"
- 6. Enter number of years in the field for the question "If your parent or legal guardian is currently living in Texas, how many years have they been living there?"
- 7. Enter number of months in the field for the question "If your parent or legal guardian is currently living in Texas, how may months have they been living there?"
- 8. Answer "What is your parent's or legal guardian's main purpose for being in the state?"
- 9. Answer Yes or No to the question "Does your parent or legal guardian have ownership interest and customarily manage a business in Texas without the intention of liquidation in the foreseeable future?"
- 10. Answer Yes or No to the question "Has your parent or legal guardian been gainfully employed in Texas for the past 12 months?"
- 11. Answer Yes or No to the question "Has your parent or legal guardian received primary support from a social services agency for the past 12 months?"
- 12. Answer Yes or No to the question "Is your parent or legal guardian married to a person who either: owns property in Texas, owns a business in Texas, is gainfully employed in Texas, or has received primary support from a social service agency?"
- 13. If yes, indicate which question could be answered 'yes' by your parent or legal guardian's spouse.
- 14. Answer "When did your parent or legal guardian marry the Texas Resident?"

Click Next to advance to Page 2.

Page 2 – Extracurriculars Extracurricular section not required. Click Next to advance to Page 3 of 4.

Page 3 – Community/Volunteer Service Community/Volunteer Service section not required. Click Next to advance to Page 4 of 4.

Page 4 – Awards/Honors

Talents, Awards, Honors section not required. Click Done.
